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HEIGHTENED SECURITY AND TRAFFIC DIVERSIONS AROUND SOUTH JAKARTA DISTRICT COURT

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The police are implementing heightened security measures at the South Jakarta District Court, Jl. Ampera Raya No. 133, Ragunan, South Jakarta ([map](#)) on Monday 17 October due to the trial of former police general Ferdy Sambo and others related to the murder of Brigadier Yosua Hutabarat (Brigadier J). Protesters could gather at the South Jakarta District Court during the trial.

Security authorities are also preparing to reroute traffic in anticipation of traffic congestion that may occur during the trial. According to the South Jakarta Police's head of operations Adj. Sr. Comr. Ruslan Idris, the rerouting will depend on the situation in accordance with the dynamics and developments on the ground but is likely to commence from 1000hrs.

The Ferdy Sambo case has entered a new phase of evidence at trial after the Criminal Investigation Police investigators handed over stage II suspects and evidence with a total of 12 case files for 11 suspects to the prosecutor's office on Wednesday (05/10). The defendants include Ferdy Sambo, who was involved in the premeditated murder of Brigadier Joshua and obstruction of justice, Putri Candrawati (Sambo's wife), and Kuat Ma'ruf. Two of the defendants were members of the National Police in the premeditated murder case, namely Richard Eliezer Pudihang Lumio and Ricky Rizal Wibowo.

Followings are the traffic arrangements prepared around the South Jakarta District Court:

1. Traffic flow from Jl. Pejaten towards Jl. Ampera Raya will be turned right to Jl. Madrasah
2. Vehicles coming from Jl. Madrasah towards Jl. Ampera Raya will be turned left to Jl. Pejaten
3. Traffic from Jl. TB Simatupang eastbound towards Jl. Ampera Raya will be directed to Ragunan
4. Vehicles coming from Jl. Cilandak KKO towards Jl. Ampera Raya will be turned right to Ragunan
5. Traffic from Jl. TB Simatupang towards Jl. Ampera Raya will have to make a detour through Fatmawati
