LARGE-SCALE PROTEST AT DPR/MPR RI BUILDING IN JAKARTA

27 August 2026

Risk Level: **Medium-High**



A large-scale protest is scheduled to take place in front of the House of Representatives (DPR/MPR RI) building on Jl. Gatot Subroto in Senayan, Central Jakarta, on Thursday 27 August from 1000hrs. Multiple civil society coalitions, including the United Pati Community Alliance (AMPB), the Red and White Brigade, and the Bogor Raya Alliance, are mobilising regional groups to gather at the DPR/MPR RI building's premises.

A 12-person advance team from AMPB has set up a coordination tent near the DPR/MPR RI complex. On Monday 24 August, a bus carrying 17 AMPB members—whose vehicle had previously been pelted with bricks by two unidentified individuals from a pedestrian bridge at the KM 54–55 km of the Jakarta-Cikampek Toll Road (in the Karawang area, West Java)—arrived in Jakarta, bringing the total number of participants to between 29 and 30. The action coordinator stated that a larger wave of participants, approximately 500 people, is expected to arrive on Wednesday 26 August.

Demands

AMPB's two national demands are:

- Immediate passage of the Asset Forfeiture Bill.
- The death penalty for people convicted of corruption.

In addition to the AMPB movement, other groups planning to participate in the 27 August protest are championing agendas focused on eradicating corruption, ensuring transparency, and investigating alleged financial mismanagement at the local government level.

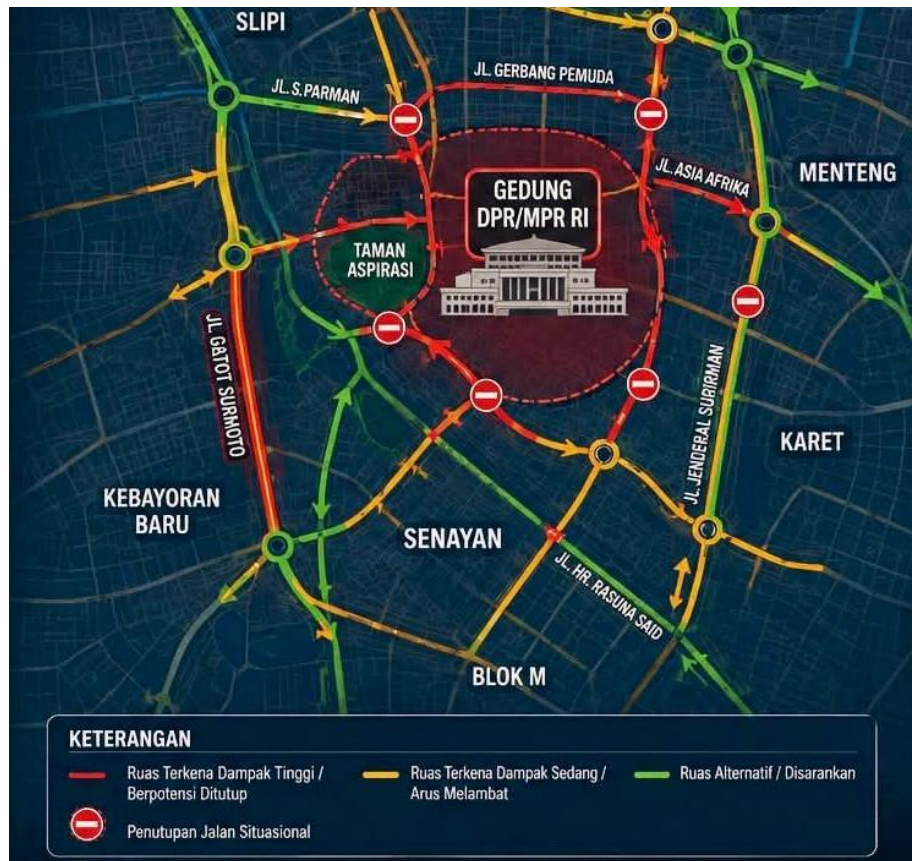
Security Measures

The Jakarta Police have been notified about the planned protest and will deploy a considerable number of personnel to monitor and guard the actions. Increased security measures around the DPR/MPR RI building are almost certain. Traffic and business disruptions are expected due to the presence of large numbers of people. Protesters may march along or block roadways. Officials may implement traffic diversion for motorists around the protest site. The police may move to disperse overly disruptive crowds, possibly leading to clashes.

Traffic disruptions are expected on Jl. Gatot Subroto towards Slipi, Jl. Gelora (rear entrance of DPR/MPR building), Jl. Asia Afrika, Jl. Gerbang Pemuda near Senayan Park (Spark) Mall in Central Jakarta. The Jakarta Traffic Police are preparing several arrangements to reroute the traffic in anticipation of worsened congestion around the DPR/MPR RI building. Clients are advised to take alternative routes to avoid traffic congestion.

The traffic diversions around the DPR/MPR RI building are as follows:

- Traffic flow from Jl. Gatot Subroto towards DPR/MPR RI building will be turned left at Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
- Vehicles coming from Slipi towards Jl. Gerbang Pemuda will be closed and directed to Semanggi
- Traffic from inner-city toll road wishing to take the exit at Offramp Pulo Dua will be diverted to Tomang toll road
- Vehicles coming from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gatot Subroto will be directed to make a U-turn back to Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
- Traffic from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gelora will be diverted to Jl. Asia Afrika
- Traffic flow from Jl. Palmerah Timur towards Jl. Gelora will be rerouted to Jl. Tentara Pelajar



Pegasus Advice

- Avoid the DPR/MPR RI building area and surrounding routes on Thursday 27 August.
- Flexible working arrangements considered for offices close to government/demonstration locations.
- Consider remote working for personnel/employees whose normal commute passes the DPR/MPR RI building.
- Reschedule important meetings away from the area.
- The protest is prone to provocateurs who could incite peaceful protests into chaos, including vandalism and violence.
- For everyday commuters, Thursday's protest could result in prolonged delays and reduced availability of ride-hailing services. Increased demand for alternative modes of transport is possible.
- Public transport routes passing near Central Jakarta, including specific Transjakarta corridors, might experience adjustments or delays.
- Temporary restrictions on access to government buildings may be applied.
- Clashes may erupt if protesters attempt to breach security barriers or block major roads.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
- Bear in mind that terrorists may use the situation to launch attacks at anytime and anywhere.
- Be advised that foreigners who join protests in Indonesia may be arrested and/or deported.
