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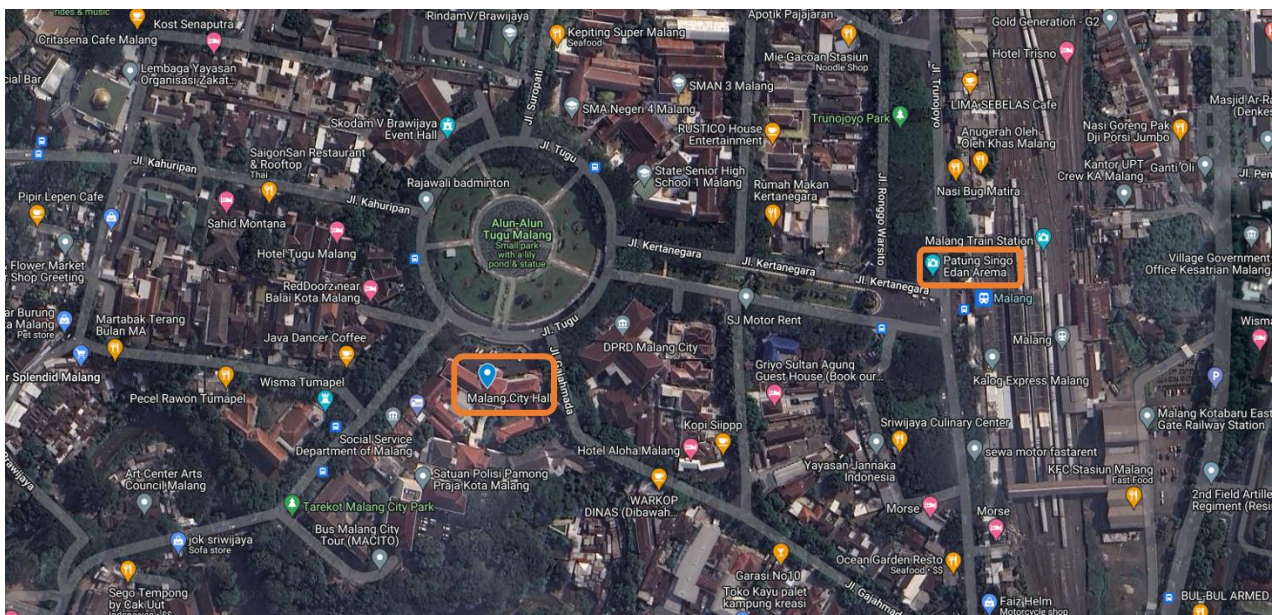
ONLINE DRIVERS DEMONSTRATION AT MALANG CITY HALL IN EAST JAVA

18 September

Ride-hailing mobile application drivers who are part of the Malang Online Bersatu (MOB) will stage a demonstration outside Malang City Hall at Jl. Tugu No.1, Kiduldalem in East Java from 0900hrs until 1430hrs on Monday 18 September to demand an increase in the base fare for transport services booked through ride-hailing apps as well as the clarity over a legal umbrella for professional online drivers.

According to one of the MOB chairs for the Malang City area, Eko Wahyu, around 2,000 online drivers plan to gather at the lion statue in front of Malang Railway Station, Jl. Trunojoyo No. 10. The convoy will then march towards the Malang City Hall by taking the following route: Brawijaya Museum, Jl. Besar Ijen – Jl. Kawi – Jl. Arif Rahman Hakim – Jl. Basuki Rahmat – Jl. Kahuripan – Jl. Tugu – and will end at the Malang City Hall.

Malang is approximately 90 km south of Surabaya.



Security Measures

The Malang Police (Polresta Malang Kota) confirmed that they have received notice of the demonstration and will increase security in and around the Malang City Hall by means of deploying personnel to the locations. Clashes are possible if security forces forcibly disperse the protesters. Transport disruptions are likely on roadways along and near the rally route. The Head of the Malang City Transportation Agency,

Widjaja Saleh Putra, said his agency is preparing to reroute traffic around the Malang City Hall on Monday 18 September in anticipation of traffic congestion that may occur during the demonstration.

Pegasus Advice

- Avoid the protest march route and its surrounding areas due to significant traffic disruption and possible clashes.
- Expect traffic delays in the vicinity of the protest venue.
- Authorities may close roads that are part of any convoy or march route and nearby streets.
- Increased demand for alternative modes of transport is possible in Malang during the action.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
