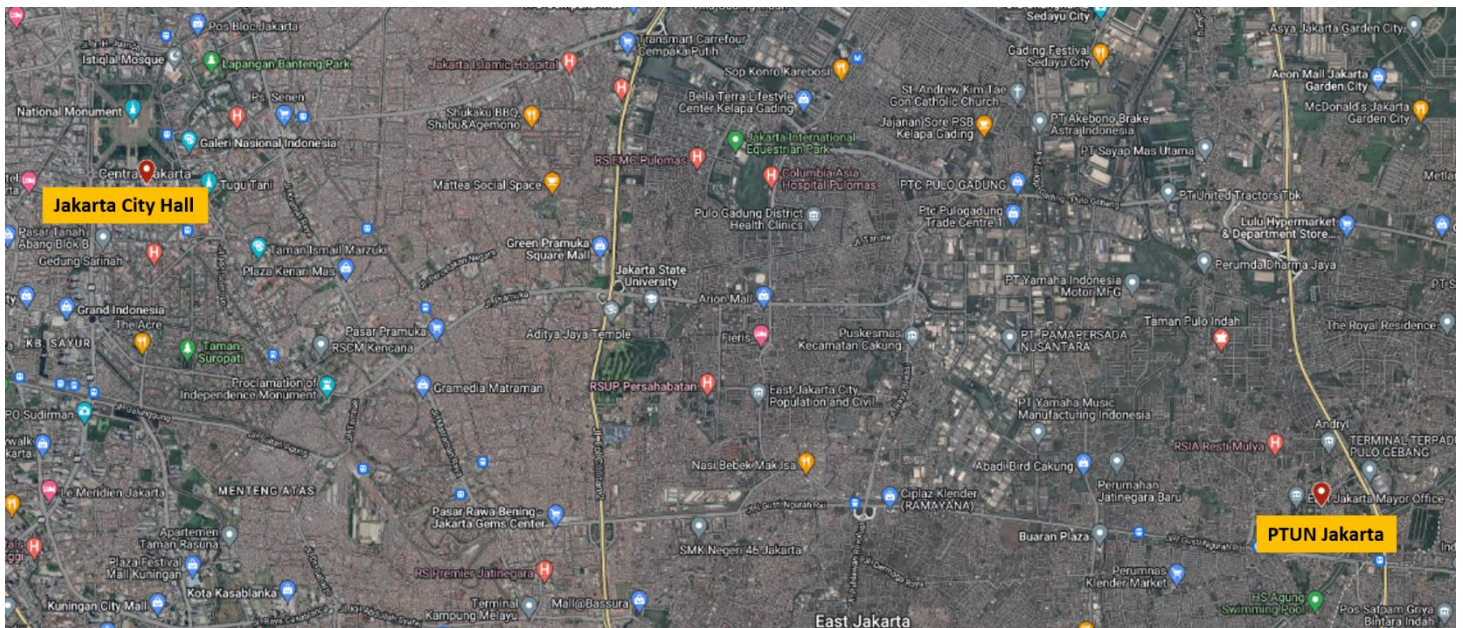


LABOUR UNIONS PROTESTS AT JAKARTA CITY HALL AND STATE ADMINISTRATIVE COURT

19 July 2022

Various labour organisations including the Confederation of Indonesian Trade Unions (KSPI), the Indonesian Metal Workers Federation (FSPMI), and the Confederation of Indonesian Prosperity Trade Unions (KSBSI) are reportedly set to stage protests at the Jakarta City Hall, Jl. Medan Merdeka Selatan, Central Jakarta, and the Jakarta State Administrative Court (PTUN), Jl. A Sentra Primer, Pulo Gebang, East Jakarta, on Tuesday 19 July from 1000hrs to denounce the Jakarta PTUN's decision to nullify legislation that raised the minimum wage. According to the President of the Confederation of Indonesian Trade Unions (KSPI) Said Iqbal, around 500-1,000 workers will take part in the protests.



BACKGROUND

The Jakarta State Administrative Court (PTUN) on Tuesday 12 July overturned Gubernurial Decree No. 1517 of 2021 on the 2022 Provincial Minimum Wage (UMP) for which a lawsuit was filed by the Jakarta Regional Leadership Council of the Indonesian Employers Association (Apindo). In addition to revoking the Governor's Decree, the Jakarta PTUN, in its ruling also requires Governor Anies Baswedan, as the defendant, to withdraw his decree No. 1517 of 2021 on the 2022 Provincial Minimum Wage issued on 16 December 2021.

According to another ruling, Governor Baswedan is required to issue a new state administrative decree regarding the 2022 provincial minimum wage based on the recommendation of the Jakarta Wage Council, which amounts to Rp4,573,845.

Earlier, Governor Baswedan had revised Governor's Decree No. 1395 of 2021 to increase the 2022 UMP by 5.1%, or Rp225,668, from the 2021 UMP of Rp4,416,186. The increase in amount was more significant than the earlier set hike of Rp37,749, or 0.85%. Jakarta Deputy Governor Ahmad Riza Patria said the provincial government was considering the opportunity to file an appeal against the court's decision.

SECURITY MEASURES

The police will impose increased security measures at and near protest sites as well as deploy a number of personnel to guard the protests. Traffic and business disruptions are likely as workers may march along or block roadways. Clashes are possible, especially if authorities forcibly disperse the demonstrators. Officials may use tear gas and water cannons to break up crowds.

PEGASUS ADVICE

- Avoid areas where the protest is occurring and exercise caution if within the vicinity of any large gathering.
- Allow additional travel time along and near the protest sites.
- Follow all security personnel instructions.
- Expect road closures and significant traffic disruptions.
- Do not attempt to cross roadblocks, as protesters may react violently.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
- Bear in mind that terrorists may use the situation to launch attacks at anytime and anywhere.
- Be advised that foreigners who join protests in Indonesia may be arrested and/or deported.
