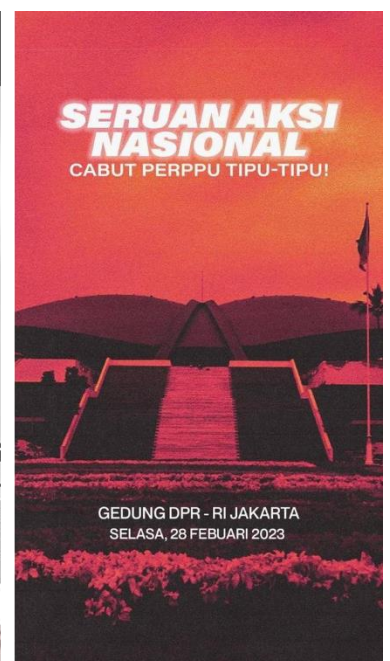


MASS PROTEST DENOUNCING JOB CREATION LAW AT DPR/MPR BUILDING IN JAKARTA

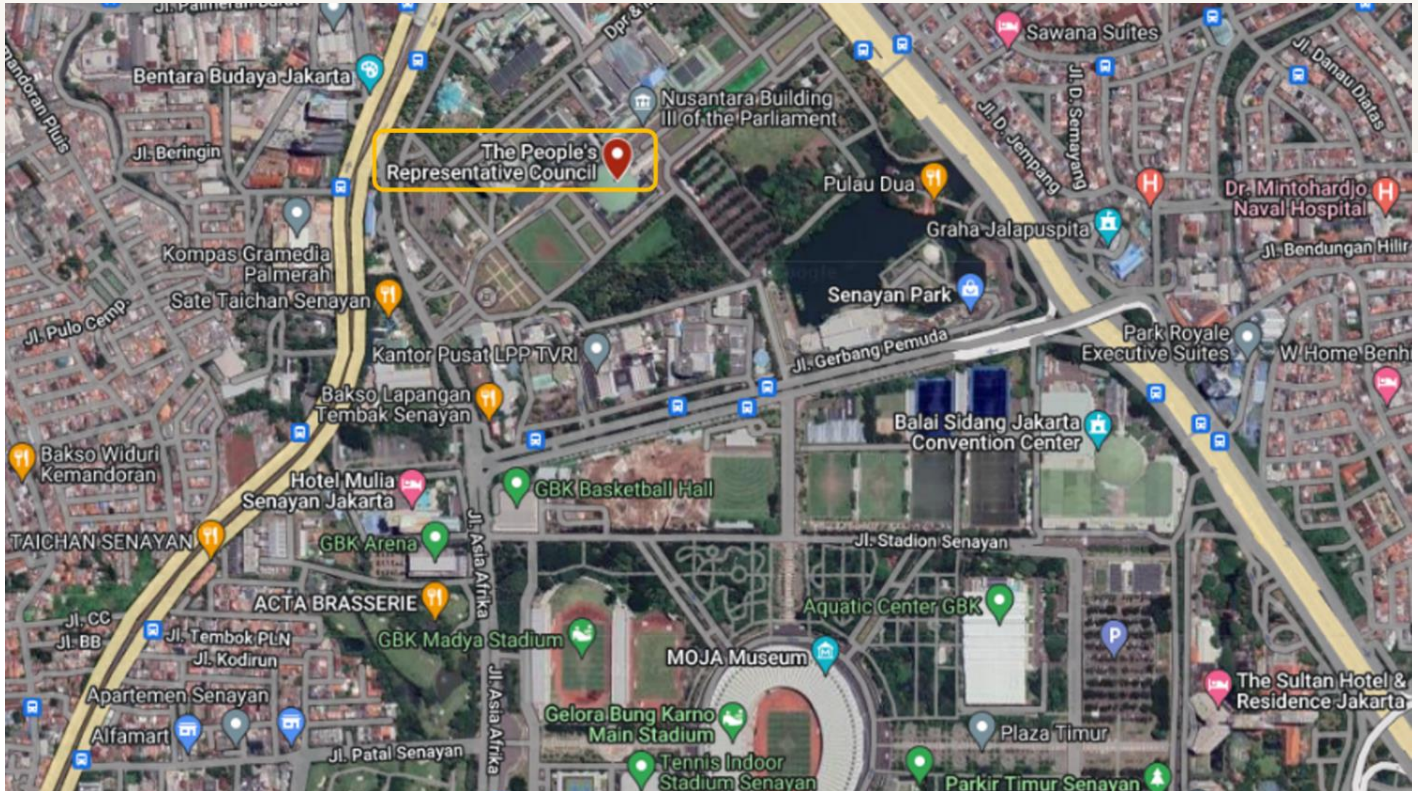


Hundreds to thousands of people from 66 student and civil society groups such as the All-Indonesia Workers Union Confederation (KSPSI), Jakarta Legal Aid Institute (LBH Jakarta), and the Student Executive Body (BEM) of the University of Indonesia (UI) will stage a protest at the House of Representatives (DPR/MPR RI) building, Jl. Gatot Subroto, Central Jakarta from 1000hrs on Tuesday 28 February. The action is in response to several issues including protests against Perppu Number 2 of 2022 concerning Job Creation. Protesters are reportedly to assemble at the Taman Ria Senayan Complex, Jl. Gerbang Pemuda, prior to marching towards the DPR/MPR RI building.

SECURITY MEASURES

At the time this report is being written, no statement has been released yet by the Jakarta Police (Polda Metro Jaya) regarding the exact figures of deployed personnel to beef up security during the protest, however, heightened security measures, including roadblocks and cordons, are likely at the DPR/MPR RI building and surrounding areas. Nearby transportation and business disruptions are possible, particularly if protesters occupy roads nearby demonstration venues. Traffic disruptions may occur along

Jl. Gatot Subroto and Jl. Gerbang Pemuda. Police could conduct mass arrests if protesters refuse to disperse when ordered to do so.



The Jakarta Traffic Police may implement the closure of several roads and diversions of traffic in anticipation of heightened gridlock around the DPR/MPR RI building. The traffic diversions are usually as follows:

1. Traffic flow from Jl. Gatot Subroto towards DPR/MPR RI building will be turned left to Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
2. Vehicles coming from Slipi towards Jl. Gerbang Pemuda will be closed and directed to Semanggi
3. Traffic from inner-city toll road wishing to take exit at Offramp Pulo Dua will be diverted to Tomang toll road
4. Vehicles coming from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gatot Subroto will be directed to make a U-turn back to Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
5. Traffic from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gelora will be diverted to Jl. Asia Afrika
6. Traffic flow from Jl. Palmerah Timur towards Jl. Gelora will be rerouted to Jl. Tentara Pelajar

Clients are advised to seek alternative routes to avoid traffic congestion and demonstrations.

PEGASUS ADVICE

- Clients are advised not to be present in the vicinity during the events, not only because of the possibility that the rally may turn violent, but the traffic will also be likely congested. Allow additional travel time near the protest venues. Confirm business appointments in advance.
- The protest is prone to provocateurs who could incite peaceful protest into chaos, including vandalism and violence.

- Strongly consider travelling in and around the vicinity of the aforementioned areas, as provocateurs may use the situation to engage in anarchy and chaos. If you are trapped amidst the chaotic protest, immediately leave the area and inform your emergency contacts about your whereabouts.
- Traffic disruption is expected in those areas. Roads in the surrounding areas will be subject to closures and/or diversions, with little or no notice.
- Bear in mind that terrorist cells could also use the event to launch an attack.
- Report anything suspicious to the police immediately.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
- Be advised that foreigners who join protests in Indonesia may be arrested and/or deported.
