

On Wednesday 17 September, online motorcycle (ojol) drivers are scheduled to stage another round of a large-scale protest, dubbed 'Aksi 179', in front of the House of Representatives (DPR/MPR RI) building at Jl. Gatot Subroto, Senayan, Central Jakarta, from 1000hrs. The protest, organised by the Indonesian Association of Online Motorcycle Drivers (Garda Indonesia), involves drivers from various regions and is expected to gather between 2,000 and 5,000 participants. Real turnout, however, might be lower or higher.

The General Chairman of Garda Indonesia, Raden Igun Wicaksono, said the protesters intend to raise/seven key demands:

1. Immediate discussion and passing of the Online Transportation Bill.
2. Ensuring that the commission cut by ride-hailing applications does not exceed 10%.

3. Regulation of tariffs for goods and food delivery.
4. Investigation into a 5% commission cut received by the application providers.
5. Elimination of programs detrimental to drivers, such as 'aceng slots' and member order systems.
6. Replacing the current Transportation Minister, perceived as pro-application providers, with one who supports ojol drivers.
7. Thorough investigation into the deaths of an ojol driver during protests on 28 August.

The protest follows recent tensions after the killing of an ojol driver, Affan Kurniawan, by a police armoured vehicle during a previous protest, which caused significant public outcry.

ANALYSIS

This planned action is part of a series of protests/demonstrations by ojol drivers throughout 2025 over issues like commissions, fares, app policies, legal status, safety, and rights. The death of Affan Kurniawan is a recent flashpoint: his case has galvanised many in the ojol community, making justice for him a central demand.

Ride-hailing and delivery services, especially by motorcycle, are a critical part of the transport landscape in Indonesia, especially in big cities. GoTo's unit Gojek, which has more than 3.1 million motorcycle drivers on its books, and Singapore-headquartered Grab have dominated the Indonesian market for years.

SECURITY MEASURES

The security arrangements are expected to be significant, but details (e.g. police deployment, road closures, etc.) have not all been made public as of the time this advisory report is written. Traffic is likely to be disrupted near the protest site, particularly Jl. Gatot Subroto towards Slipi, Jl. Gelora (rear entrance of DPR/MPR building), Jl. Asia Afrika, and Jl. Tentara Pelajar. Traffic diversions and road closures will be implemented by the authorities on a situational basis.

1. Traffic flow from Jl. Gatot Subroto towards DPR/MPR RI building will be turned left at Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
2. Vehicles coming from Slipi towards Jl. Gerbang Pemuda will be closed and directed to Semanggi
3. Traffic from inner-city toll road wishing to take the exit at Offramp Pulo Dua will be diverted to Tomang toll road
4. Vehicles coming from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gatot Subroto will be directed to make a U-turn back to Jl. Gerbang Pemuda
5. Traffic from Jl. Gerbang Pemuda towards Jl. Gelora will be diverted to Jl. Asia Afrika
6. Traffic flow from Jl. Palmerah Timur towards Jl. Gelora will be rerouted to Jl. Tentara Pelajar



PEGASUS ADVICE

- Clients are advised not to be present in the vicinity during the protest on Wednesday 17 September, not only because of the possibility that the protests may turn violent, but the traffic is likely to be congested.
- Anticipate heightened security and overland travel disruptions near the protest location.
- The protest is prone to provocateurs who could incite peaceful protests into chaos, including vandalism and violence.
- Roads in the surrounding areas will be subject to closures and/or diversions, with little or no notice.
- Confirm business appointments in advance.
- Bear in mind that terrorist cells could also use the event to launch an attack.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
- Be advised that foreigners who join protests in Indonesia may be arrested and/or deported.
