



PA 212 ANNUAL MASS REUNION RALLY AT NATIONAL MONUMENT IN JAKARTA

2 December 2025




Members of the Muslim group Alumni Brotherhood (PA) 212 are scheduled to hold the mass reunion rally under the official theme of ‘The Moral Revolution to Save the Republic of Indonesia from Criminals and Free Palestine from Occupiers’ at the National Monument (Monas) area in Central Jakarta on Tuesday 2 December. The spokesperson for the PA 212 mass reunion, Aziz Yanuar, stated that, unlike previous years, instead of starting with *qiyamullail* (night prayer) leading to dawn prayer, this year’s reunion reportedly will begin with congregational Maghrib (evening prayer), followed by *zikir*, communal prayers, and *tausiyah* (sermons by scholars).

The Chair of the Steering Committee (SC), Ahmad Shobri Lubis, stated that the event is expected to be attended by thousands of people from various backgrounds. He said they had extended invitations broadly to government officials, including President

Prabowo Subianto and other ministers, as well as other relevant public figures. Also, according to some reports, former governor Anies Baswedan was among the invitees but had not yet confirmed his presence. Rizieq Shihab is also scheduled to attend the mass reunion.

ANALYSIS

PA 212, which is closely associated with the controversial Islam Defenders Front (FPI), is known as the driving force behind the sectarian rally held on 2 December 2016 to demand the prosecution of then-Jakarta governor Basuki 'Ahok' Tjahaja Purnama for blasphemy. In 2021, hundreds of participants were adamant about holding the PA 212 mass reunion rally at Monas in Central Jakarta without a crowd permit, leading to the closure of Monas and road closures around the area as security personnel attempted to disperse the crowds. In 2023, after they failed to obtain a permit for Monas and the Istiqlal Mosque also said it was reluctant to host the gathering, the group decided to move the annual mass event to At-Tin Mosque in East Jakarta, citing COVID-19 precautions.

SECURITY MEASURES

At the time this advisory report is being written, no public announcement with concrete numbers of police or crowd-control personnel similar to previous years. In 2024, the Jakarta Police deployed 2,489 officers to monitor the reunion. A similar scale is likely to be dispatched. Traffic diversions and road closures may be implemented on a situational basis. Expect traffic disruptions along Jl. Medan Merdeka Selatan, Jl. Medan Merdeka Utara, and Jl. Medan Merdeka Barat in Central Jakarta.



PEGASUS ADVICE

- Avoid Monas and surrounding areas on the evening of Tuesday 2 December as a precaution.
- Anticipate robust security and overland travel disruptions near the location of the rally.
- Allow additional travel time to reach destinations near the rally venue.
- Leave the area at the first sign of security disturbance.
- Stay current with media coverage of local events, be aware of your surroundings, and practise personal security awareness at all times.
- Bear in mind that terrorists and/or radical elements could infiltrate the protests and may use the situation to launch attacks at anytime and anywhere.
- Be advised that foreigners who join protests in Indonesia may be arrested and/or deported.
