DEMONSTRATION TIMELINE AT DPR/MPR RI BUILDING IN JAKARTA

27-28 August 2026

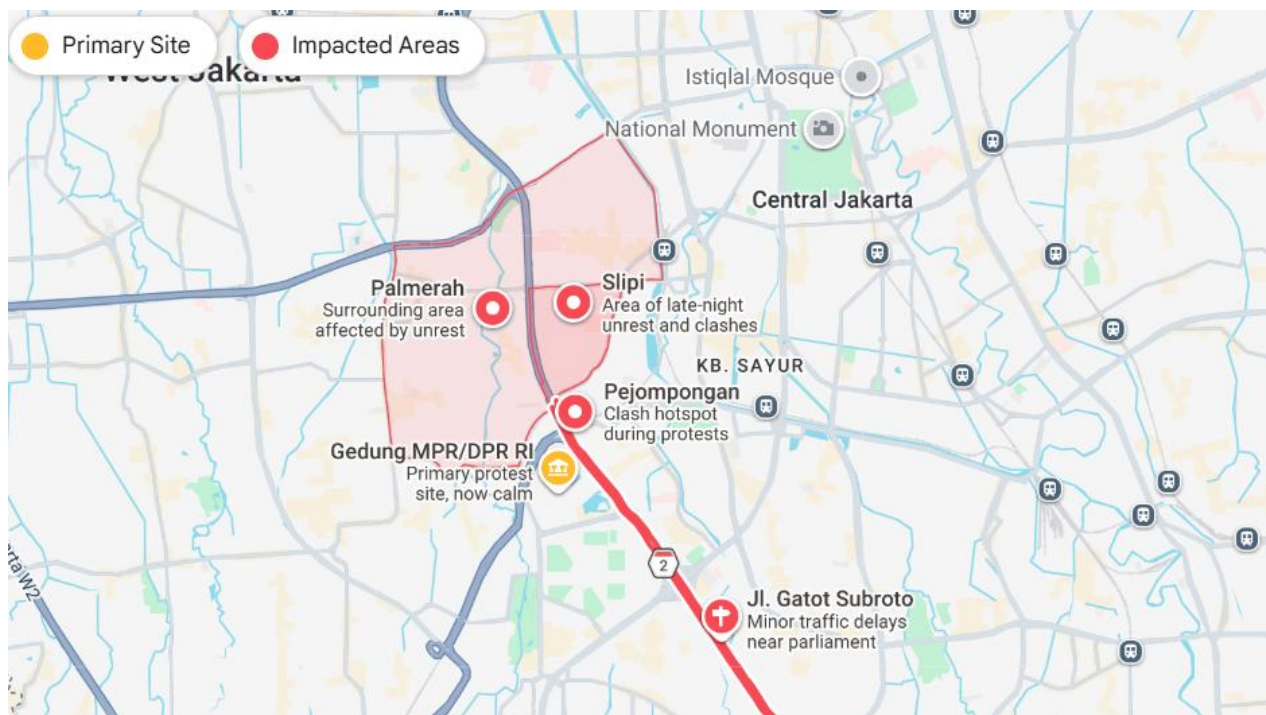
Risk Level: Medium-High

As of Friday morning 28 August, the situation around the DPR/MPR RI building in Central Jakarta is not yet fully normal. While the main demonstration on Thursday 27 August has ended, residual groups of protesters remain in several locations, and traffic around the parliament building is still disrupted.

No large-scale demonstration is confirmed for Friday 28 August. However, residual crowds and the anniversary of Affan Kurniawan's death create a risk of spontaneous gatherings.

Time	Development of Situation
Thursday 27 August	
1600hrs onwards	A separate/remaining crowd, including student elements, continued to gather around the DPR/MPR RI building after the AMPB group had largely dispersed.
1800hrs	Clashes/escalation were reported around the DPR/MPR RI building, followed by police crowd-control measures including water cannons and tear gas. At least 65 people were detained and still being held by police following the dispersal.
1845hrs	A crowd was reported around the Palmerah-Tanah Abang railway corridor. Commuter Line halted Tanah Abang-bound services for safety.
1900hrs	Reports indicated protesters had moved towards Jl. Pejompongan, Jl. Palmerah Utara, and the Inner-City Toll Road, with some toll access points affected/closed. Clashes with police developed there. A motorcycle was set ablaze.
2000hrs	Reports from Slipi flyover described protesters confronting police, including the use of fireworks and stone against officers.
2124hrs	Slipi Police Post on Jl. S. Parman was reportedly set ablaze.
2200hrs-2250hrs	Further clashes occurred around Pejompongan and Slipi; police reinforced the area, pushed protesters back, and repeatedly deployed tear gas.
Friday 28 August	

0000hrs-0300hrs	Crowds continued to gather around Slipi, Petamburan, and parts of Jl. Gatot Subroto. Movement towards Slipi and Pejompongan continued, with some burning objects and trucks reported near Wisma 77 building. Tear gas residue was still noticeable.
0400hrs-0530hrs	Residual crowds were still reported around Slipi, Petamburan, and Pejompongan, while authorities assessed damage around the DPR/MPR RI building and surrounding infrastructure.
0600hrs	Inner-City toll road access reopened after an earlier temporary closure caused by residual crowds around the DPR/MPR RI building. Jasa Marga reported traffic as normal.
0620hrs	Commuter Line train (KRL) Palmerah-Tanah Abang remained affected by crowd activity; operational adjustments continued to be reported.
0700hrs	Crowds still present at Slipi TL intersection and traffic around Jl. Gatot Subroto not fully normal.
0830hrs onwards	The traffic on Jl. Gatot Subroto in front of the DPR/MPR RI building reopened.



Pegasus Advice

- As a precaution the area around Senayan, Slipi, Palmerah, Petamburan, and Pejompongan.
- Some roads are fully open, but motorists should expect minor security checkpoints and residual crowds, especially on Jl. Pejompongan Raya near Slipi flyover.
- Expect increased police deployment and crowd-control measures.
- Anticipate potential continuation of actions on Friday 28 August, particularly around the anniversary of Affan Kurniawan's death and in response to the arrests.

- Consider work-from-home/flexible working for personnel who do not need to be physically present, particularly if further demonstrations are announced.
- Monitor local media for updates.
- Verify the date and location of demonstration videos, as old footage may be recirculated as current.
- The situation remains fluid, and further developments should be expected as the day progresses.

Pegasus will continue to monitor the situation during events and will inform the clients through SMS alerts if major incidents occur.
